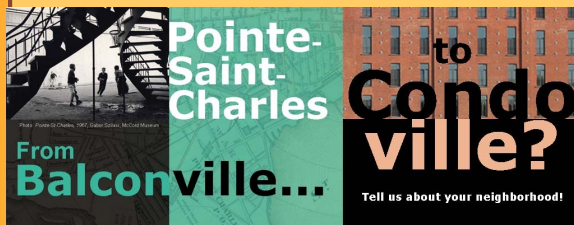


Announcements:

Intro to Video Editing Workshop, Wednesday November 7th, 6:00pm-8:00pm:

Introduction to video editing with the software Adobe Premiere Elements. You will learn to work on a video, clip it, add titles and some basic effects. It is strongly suggested for affiliates who wish to work with video materials.

Intro to Radio Production (Part I) Wednesday November 14th, 6:00pm-9:00pm

This workshop is a hand-on training for learning how to produce your own audio piece. By the end of the workshop, you will be able to use an audio recorder (either an Edirol or a Zoom), to transfer your sounds to a computer and to use Audacity (for editing in single and multi-track mode).
